Words and Deeds: Holding Governments Accountable in the Beijing +15 Review Process

Over sixty years ago, countries adopting the Universal Declaration of Human Rights proclaimed that "all human beings are born free and equal in dignity and rights." That fundamental right has echoed for decades in conferences, treaties, and declarations. In 1995, in the Platform for Action adopted in Beijing, 189 governments agreed that laws that discriminate against women undermine equality, and pledged to "revoke any remaining laws that discriminate on the basis of sex." Yet inequality, even in its most overt form, has not been vanquished. While discrimination against

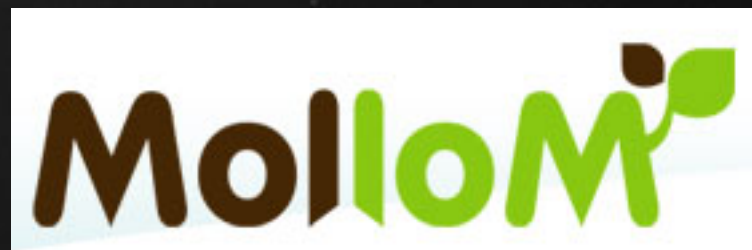
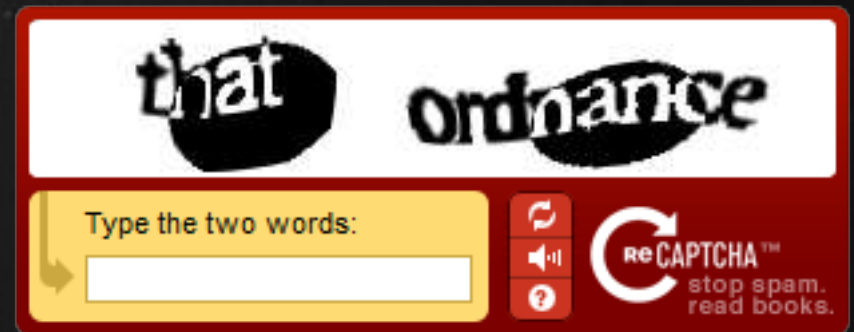

منذ فترة تزيد على ستين عاما، أعلنت البلدان التي اعتمدت الإعلان العالمي لحقوق الإنسان أن "جميع الناس يولدون أحرارا ومتساوين في الكرامة والحقوق." وقد تردد صدى هذا الحق الأساسي عقودا من الزمن في المؤتمرات والمعاهدات والإعلانات. في عام 1995، وفي منهاج العمل الذي اعتمد في بيجين، إتفقت 189 حكومة على أن القوانين التي تميز ضد المرأة تقوّض المساواة، وتعدت "بالغاء أي قوانين متبقية تتطوي على التمييز القائم على أساس الجنس." غير أنه لم يتم دحر عدم المساواة، حتى في أكثر أشكاله العلنية. ورغم أن التمييز ضد المرأة مستمر حول العالم ويتخذ أشكالا مختلفة، فإن القوانين التي تميز صراحة ضد المرأة تدل على دعم الدول للتمييز، وتعدّ رمزا لعدم إحترام الحكومات الواضح لحق المرأة الأساسي في المساواة، وللتأييد الرسمي للتقليل من شأن المرأة

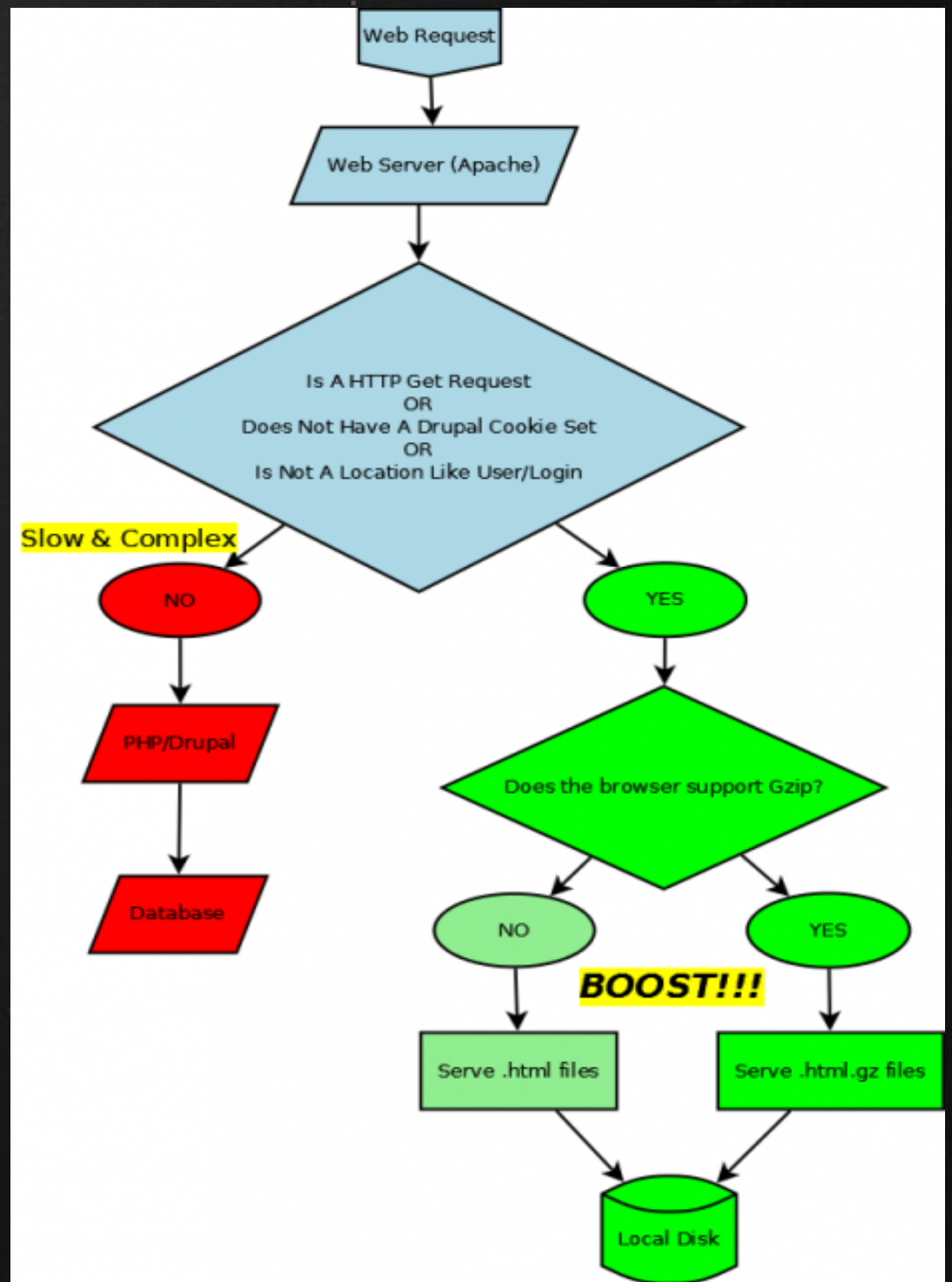
