- Calendar – displays a calendar for events on your site

- Organic groups – Enables users to create and manage their own groups. <http://drupal.org/project/og>
- Simplenews – email newsletter management

- Forum – This module is part of drupal core. For creating a discussion forum, this is where you start.

- Zen starterkit theme – Want your community to look hot? A solid base theme to start out. <http://drupal.org/project/zen>
- Imagefield – Let your users post images!

- Fivestar – Allows your users rate content. Adds a clean, attractive voting widget to nodes. <http://drupal.org/project/fivestar>

- Google analytics – quick and easy way to enable powerful traffic metrics on your site http://drupal.org/project/google_analytics
