Friends of Friends Referral Program

Overview

NTEN is committed to providing a meaningful and sustainable learning experience for the nonprofit community through the annual Nonprofit Technology Conference. With each additional attendee, we have a larger impact on the field and grow closer to achieving financial independence for the event.

We know that the single biggest reason people attend the Nonprofit Technology Conference (NTC) is the recommendation of a colleague or friend. To acknowledge this word-of-mouth (and mouse) promotion, NTEN is initiating an **NTC Referral Program**, and we are inviting you to participate. The conditions of this program are detailed below, but feel free to contact us if you have any questions.

How does the Friends of Friends Referral Program work?

The NTC registration system will track referrals in a special field in the conference registration process. People referred by you should choose your organization's name in this field when they sign up for the conference. Your organization must be an NTEN organizational member to participate in this program, and **you must be signed up by February 1st, 2007.**

What do you get?

The referring organization will receive **1 free 2007 NTC registration** for every 10 paid first-time NTC attendees. These credits can only be applied to the 2007 NTC in Washington, DC, are non-transferable, and can not be redeemed for cash. A maximum of 5 free NTC registrations will be awarded per participating organization.

What do you have to do?

Get people's attention! Referral program participants should send at least one dedicated email regarding the NTC to their opt-in contact base at least 8 weeks prior to the conference. A copy of this email must be sent to holly@nten.org at the time of its distribution. Use of the sample text below is encouraged, but please feel free to personalize your message.

Spamming

You hate spam; we hate spam; so don't spam! You may only send a referral to people who have opted to receive communications from you or are in your employees' personal networks. Any report of unsolicited referral email in volume will result in immediate cancellation of the referral program credit.

2. Rules and Limitations

- Credits can be applied only to the 2007 NTC in Washington, DC.
- Credits are non-transferable.
- Credits cannot be redeemed for cash.
- Fewer than 10 registrations will not result in partial credits.
- A maximum of 5 free NTC registrations will be awarded per participating organization.
- Program results will be shared with participating organizations within 90 days after the NTC, and credits will be issued at that time.
- If a referred attendee cancels their registration at any time, the referring organization will not get credit for that referral.
- Only current NTEEN organizational members are eligible for this program.
- All participating organizations must be **signed up by** February 1, 2007.
- There is no penalty for failing to register 10 people.

3. Spamming

No spamming or bulk emailing is allowed. You may only send a referral to people who have opted to receive communications from you or are in your employees' personal networks. Any report of unsolicited referral email in volume will result in immediate cancellation of referral program credit.

4. Contract Acceptance
